

Important Supplier Communication: Waste Management Acquisition of ADS

What is happening ? Waste Management will complete its acquisition of ADS (Advanced Disposal Services) in late **Q3** or early **Q4**.

How will this affect your company?

As an ADS supplier you should continue to do business with all non-divesting ADS locations in the **usual manner** regarding:

- Accepting orders
- Providing invoicing
- Receiving payments

In the future, ADS locations will be migrated onto the WM (Waste Management) procurement platform. Information regarding the timing and schedule for this migration will be available at wm.com/suppliers. Please check the website frequently for information concerning the acquisition. If you are not registered as a WM supplier, please click the Supplier Registration link on wm.com/suppliers to register.

Note: If your company has contract pricing with WM and ADS, you will **immediately** apply the pricing most favorable to both.

What about Divested locations?

A list of divested ADS and WM locations that your company has done business with in the last twelve (12) months will be posted to wm.com/suppliers immediately following the close of the transaction with the buyer(s). Please check the website frequently.

When will ADS move to the WM procurement platform?

We expect to complete the migration of ADS locations onto the WM procurement platform in **Q12021**. More information regarding the cut-over timing and schedule will be posted to wm.com/suppliers. Please check the website frequently.

Will there be training?

Yes. Necessary on-boarding instructions will be posted to wm.com/suppliers in advance of the transition to the WM procurement platform. Please check the website frequently.
