HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The Bevel Creek lift station is a triplex station that delivers over 60% of the wastewater flow to Land Application System. Currently, the county is running on two pumps at this station. The pump that is out of service is a Flygt pump that was built in 1992. Staff received a quote to repair this pump for \$40,063.50. Two additional quotes were received for a new Flygt pump for \$58,097.10 and a new Wilo pump for \$38,930.50. After considerable research staff recommends the purchase of the Wilo pump at the Bevel Creek lift station.
