

## ANAPHYLAXIS

**Stable Hemodynamics** (SBP > 100) with minor or moderate skin manifestations (itching, rash, blotches, hives, urticaria), and **no respiratory compromise**.

### STABLE PATIENT

Routine Medical Care  
Assess BP and respiratory status

Be alert for LOC changes and  
ANY signs of respiratory  
compromise.

Pronounced skin rash,  
itching, blotches,  
hives and/or urticaria  
Peripheral Cyanosis  
Wheezing or  
Stridorous  
respirations  
Anxiety  
Confusion

### UNSTABLE PATIENT

SBP < 100 with significant skin manifestations itching, rash, blotches, hives, urticaria and **respiratory compromise**.
