# **Aspirin**

**Indication**: Onset chest pain suggestive of MI signs/symptoms

Adult dose range: 160mg-325mg chewable tablets

Pediatric dose range: Not recommended

**Time to onset:** 15 to 30 minutes

#### **Contraindications:**

- DO NOT GIVE TO PEDIATRIC PATIENTS
- Hypersensitivity to aspirin
- Stomach ulcers
- GI Bleeding

### How is it given?

• Orally

### What should be monitored?

- Heart rate
- Respiratory Rate

## Major drug interactions:

• Blood Thinners

#### What side effects/potential complications are expected?

- Do not give large amounts of water to drink, as vomiting may occur
- Relatively contraindicated in persons with asthma
