stated that recommended improvements will be funded through operational cost savings. Mr. Pritchard further stated that if the Commission chose to refrain from moving forward with improvements, the county will owe ABM \$50,240.00 for their work on the survey, analysis and final proposal. Vice Chairman Marshall made a motion to move forward and approve the letter of intent as presented, Commissioner Griner second. All voted in favor, no one opposed. Motion carried.

Approve Condemning ROW and Drainage Easement for Clyattstone Rd.-Simpson Ln. TSPLOST Paving Project

County Engineer, Mike Fletcher, presented a request in the amount of \$1,208.80, related to the condemnation of 0.147+/- acres of right of way and 0.017=/- acres for a drainage easement for the project. Commissioner Griner made a motion to approve the request as presented, Commissioner Evans second. All voted in favor, no one opposed. Motion carried.
