HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: On October 13th, 2020, the Lowndes County Board of Commissioners determined Artherman Lane, lying North of Porter Road to its dead end, has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it. As required by Georgia statute, each adjoining property owner was notified by certified mail of the intent and public hearing. The public hearing was also advertised in the Valdosta Daily Times.

WHEREAS, the Lowndes County Board of Commissioners received a request to consider abandoning Artherman Road, lying North of Porter Road to its dead end, as more fully described on the attached plat or sketch; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2(b)(1), the Board of Commissioners has determined such section of the County road system has ceased to be used by the public to the extent that no substantial public purpose is served by it; and

WHEREAS, as required by O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2(b)(1), the County Engineer has given notice to property owners located thereon;

WHEREAS, as also required by O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2(b)(1), the County Engineer has advertised once a week for two weeks for a public hearing to be held on October 27th 2020, during the regular meeting of the Lowndes County Board of Commissioners which begins at 5:30 p.m.;

WHEREAS, as required by O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2(b)(1), the Board of Commissioners has held a public hearing on the issue;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Artherman Road, lying North of Porter Road to its dead end, as more fully described on the attached plat or sketch, be and is hereby declared abandoned, such that such section of right of way shall no longer be part of the County road system and the rights of the public in and to such section of road as a public road shall cease, provided, however, that the County shall and does retain all its legal rights and interests in such right of way for purposes other than public roadway purposes including its rights to locate utilities in and to use such right of way to control drainage of surface water, including such rights under recorded utility and drainage easements.

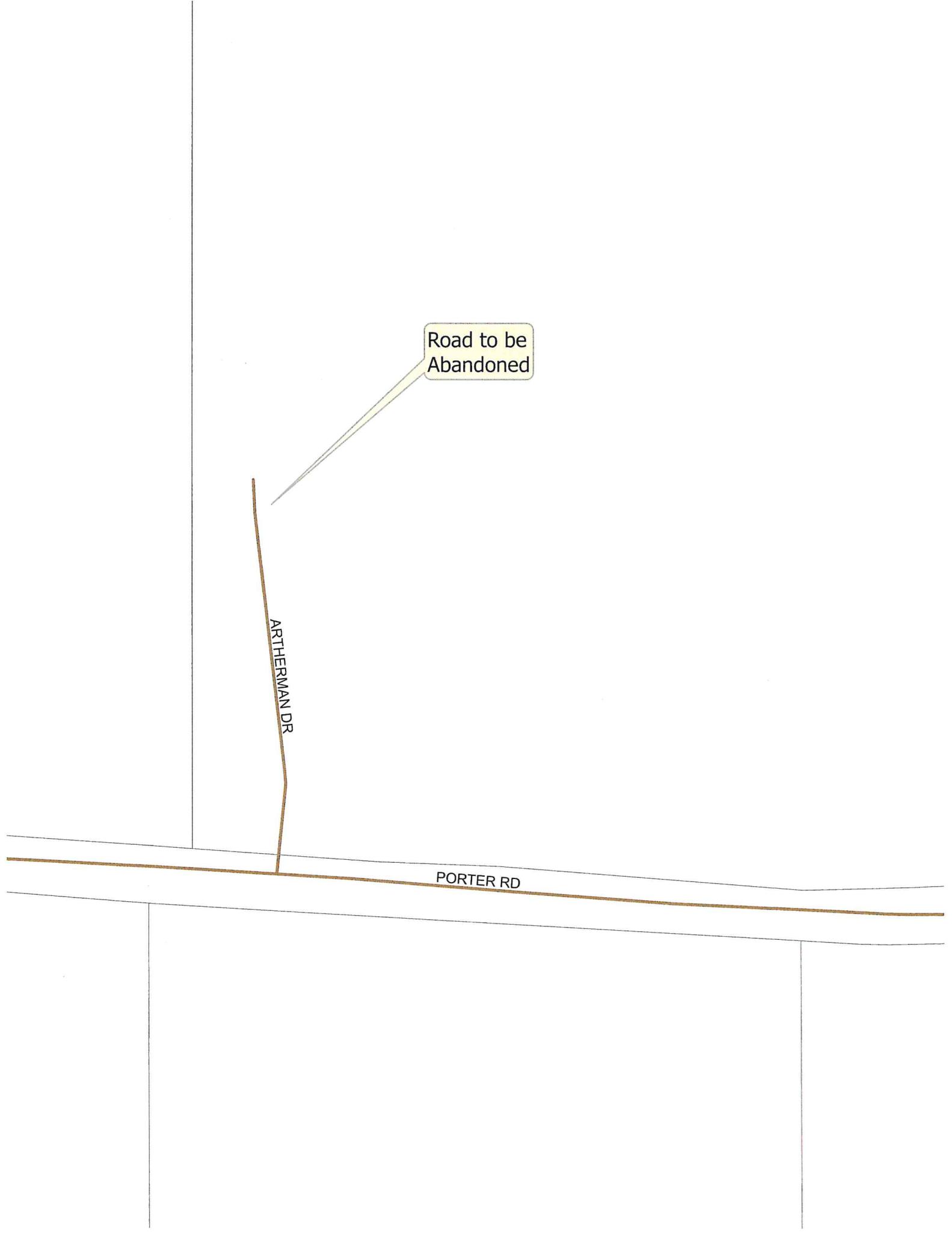

COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: 2020-2021 Solicitor-General's VOCA Continuation Grant

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The Solicitor-General's Office has received VOCA funds since April 01, 2014. This grant allows the Solicitor-General's Office to continue to provide services to victims earlier in the criminal justice process, essentially prior to the defendant's first appearance as well as help victims secure restitution through GA Crime Victims Compensation Fund Program. The match will continue to be satisfied 100% In-kind through the use of Volunteer/Intern hours has been waived this year. The county's health insurance premiums increased last year from \$8,000 to \$11,000 per employee. There is a \$6,000 cost of the county to cover the increase in health insurance premiums which applies to two Victim Advocates fully funded by the grant (\$3,000 per employee). Submission of this grant renewal is due by November 13, 2020 to Prosecuting Attorney's Council (PAC). The SG's office requests the board's approval for the VOCA continuation grant.

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: In April 2018 the Solicitor-General's office was awarded the VAWA (Violence Against Women Act) grant to hire a new Assistant Solicitor-General in the specialized field of Family Violence and Violence Against Women Crimes. The continuation grants were approved in 2019 and 2020 and it is now time to apply for a new competitive VAWA Grant. The grant award period would be January 01-December 31, 2021. This grant would also be a 4 year grant with continuation funding needing to be approved on a yearly basis. The total amount needed from Lowndes County is \$17,326.00, in the form of a Cash Match. This Cash Match amount we are asking for in this Competitive Grant is significantly lower than the previous amount of \$19,167.00. Submission of this VAWA Competitive Grant Application is due by November 02, 2020. The SG's office requests the Board's approval to submit the VAWA Competitive Grant Application.

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The District Attorney's Office of the Southern Circuit has been a recipient of federal Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) funds since 1997. The VOCA funds, combined with the 5% victim fees, provide the financial support for the Victim Services provided by the DA to all five counties. The grant is funneled through Lowndes County, rather than all five counties, for simplification and efficiency purposes. This grant, along with the 5% funds, allow the DA to provide victim services utilizing funds paid by federal and state defendants and not taxpayers. Submission of the application is due in the PAC Office by November 13, 2020. We also request, for efficiency, that the Commission execute a letter allowing the grant funds to be deposited directly to the DA's Office, rather than the funds being deposited to Lowndes County and then a check sent to the DA and also execute a letter authorizing the District Attorney to sign any and all future paperwork pertaining to this VOCA Continuation Grant.
