HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The Lowndes County Public Works Department is in need of a borrow pit for suitable soils that can be used for road build up, construction projects, shoulder rebuilding, etc. The Lowndes County Engineering Department and Public Works Department have worked together to find a parcel of land in Naylor near Lake Alapaha that meet these requirements for the specific type of soil needed. The Engineering and Public Works Departments have completed test holes in several locations throughout the parcel of land and have found this soil to be suitable for our use. Attached is the borrow pit agreement between Lowndes County and Larry & Christine Sanders for a term of up to 12 years.
