



7. Liquid wastes restricted from landfill disposal by rule 381-3-4-.04(9) shall be excluded from transfer stations. Transfer stations in existence on August 1, 2004 and in compliance with all other regulations applicable to permit by rule transfer stations may continue to handle such liquid wastes until a solid waste processing facility permit is issued or August 1, 2006, whichever occurs first.

The Rules for Solid Waste Management, Chapter 391-3-4, can be found on EPD's website at <http://epd.georgia.gov/existing-rules-and-corresponding-laws>. Please carefully review definitions and requirements pertaining to your transfer station operation. Violation of any of the applicable requirements will invalidate your permit by rule status.
