WITNESSETH: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) AND OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATIONS, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and convey, unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of the undivided interest of said parties of the first part in the following described properties, to-wit:
